Cirencester Urban Orienteering Event

Southern England Urban Orienteering League

Sunday September 16th 2018

Full range of courses for experienced orienteers and for beginners who want to have a go.

FINAL DETAILS

- The Area:** Cirencester is a historic market town and important Roman settlement (Corinivm Dobvnnorvm) sited on the ancient Fosse Way. The race area comprises the town centre, housing, parkland, school and college grounds, and the Roman amphitheatre which provide a variety of going and lots of route choice. Junior courses will be off road. This is a new map, produced by Mike Hampton and this is the first event to make use of it.
- Venue:** The Event Centre is in Cirencester College and will be signed from the A419 Stroud Road at Grid Ref SP011014 (postcode GL7 1XA). Parking is free. Toilets are provided. No catering is provided..
- Entry:** Advance entry (preferred) through Fabian 4 www.fabian4.co.uk. Advance entry closes on 11 September 2018. Entry on the day will be available while the map stock lasts.
- Times:** **Entry on Day Registration** From 10:00, **Starts** 10:30 to 12:30. **Courses close** 14:30
- Fees:** Advanced entry up to 11 September: Senior £10-00. Junior and Students £4-00.
Entry on day: Senior £12-00. Junior and Students £5-00.
Family groups on junior courses will be charged at junior rates.
- Maps:** **Courses 1 to 6** will have a **double-sided A3+** map, comprising a **1:5000** urban specification map covering the town and a **1:2500** urban specification map covering the school and college.
Course 7 will have an A4 **1:2500** urban specification map covering the school and college.
All maps will be printed on waterproof paper.
- Control descriptions will be provided on maps and loose descriptions will be provided in start lanes.
- Punching:** EMIT electronic punching will be used. EMIT card hire £1.50.
- Registration:** All enquiries on the day should be directed to the registration tent located in the assembly area.
- Hired E-cards and entry on the day available from 1000-1200. Hired EMIT cards should be handed back at Download.
- Competitors who have pre-entered and have their own E-card may go directly to the start.
- Spare back-up cards will be available from registration for those with their own EMIT cards.
- A demonstration control will be available outside registration.

Start: **Start times between 1030-1230.** It will be a punching start (not timed). Please allow event officials requiring a run to have priority if needed in your course start queue.

There are two starts. The Junior Start (Courses 6 and 7) is located at assembly.

The Senior Start (Courses 1-5) is 900m from assembly. Please allow sufficient time to walk to the start.

Dogs: Dogs are not permitted in the school nor college grounds nor on courses.

Finish: There is one finish close to assembly and download. Follow the pedestrian crossing and marked route back from the Finish to the assembly area and Download tent.

All competitors must report to the Download tent even if they retire.
