Saturday Park Sessions

Who can come?

Everyone is welcome, particularly juniors (aged 7/8 upwards), families and beginners. We ask that juniors come with a responsible adult and everyone is encouraged to join in the activities.

What do we do?

The aim is to learn some orienteering skills through games and fun activities. The advantage of a park is that there are no road traffic issues and it is possible for older juniors to do some activities more independently. These informal sessions, led by a club coach, will also be suitable for adult beginners. In the past more experienced club members have also joined in the fun.

When and where?

Sessions will be in Swindon parks from 10:30 until 12:00 on selected Saturday mornings. Dates will be posted on the NWO website under Fixtures

Cost

£2 per adult and £1 per junior. Junior members of NWO get free entry. There may be car parking charges at some park venues.

What to bring and wear?

Come in clothes suitable for easy movement and appropriate to the weather. Trainers or similar will be suitable footwear. You may encounter some mud underfoot.

Please come with a pen/pencil and a compass if you have one. There will be some compasses available to borrow.
