Cherhill Down, Calne

Acknowledgements:	Access is by kind permission of the National Trust.
Venue / Parking:	Cherhill Down is between Calne and Marlborough and will be signed from the A4 between Beckhampton and Cherhill villages. Grid Reference SU 046701. Postcode SN11 8XY Traffic on the A4 can be fast. Take care if you are turning right from or onto the A4. A narrow lane leads from the A4 to the parking area. Parking will be on grass near a fenced enclosure. Please park sensibly, observing social distancing guidelines and do not obstruct the track.
Travel:	When travelling to and from the event, participants are advised to only travel within the same vehicle with others from the same household. Participants should consider using their own vehicle and not public transport where possible.
Terrain/Hazards:	Open downland with some copse and scattered trees, hillfort and prominent monument. Fences must only be crossed at marked points.
Maps:	A4 landscape 1:10000 scale. Contours at 5m intervals.
Times:	Start Times 11.00-1200h. Courses close at 1300hrs.
Course:	1 hour score event which includes a set of yellow controls
Punching:	EMIT. Card hire fee £1.50 per competitor. Lost card charge £47.
Start & Finish:	There will be an approximately 700m uphill walk to the start and downhill from the finish to download and car parking area. Competitors should remain in the car park area and ready to go to the start at twenty minutes before their start time
Entries & Fees:	Strictly Pre-Entry ONLY – no entry on day
	Entries will be limited to a maximum of 30 individual runners or family groups. Entry will be restricted to NWO members until 6 th September. If there are any spare places after this date further entries will be available to members of British Orienteering

Facilities:	No toilet facilities provided. First Aid kit available.
Event Safety:	Every effort will be made to ensure the event is safe for competitors, volunteers and the public. We ask that at all times you adhere to the government's guidance on social distancing and follow the <u>British Orienteering's Code of Conduct</u> .
	Prior to the event, if you display symptoms of COVID-19, are required to self-isolate or are otherwise feeling unwell then you <u>must not</u> attend. Refunds will be given to those unable to attend.

There will be no car key or baggage drop. All competitors MUST download even if they do not complete the course.

	The nearest A & E Hospital is at Swindon Great Western Hospital SN3 6BB. Cagoules and whistles may be made compulsory in adverse weather.
	Participants to bring their own water and ensure adequate hydration pre and post event. Hand sanitisers will be available however we encourage participants to also bring their own.
