Local Score Event with Yellow Course Option Hens Wood, near Marlborough

Sunday 18th October 2020





Acknowledgements:	Access is by kind permission of the Ramsbury Estate. Hens Wood is private mixed woodland with a variety of wildlife.
Venue / Parking:	Hens Wood is approximately 5km east of Marlborough on the A4 to Hungerford. The track to event parking is on the north side of the A4, approx. 300m east of the turning for Great Bedwyn Station if approaching from Marlborough. Grid Reference SU248678 , nearest post code SN8 3HS . Parking is on a track adjacent to the assembly area.
Travel:	When travelling to and from the event, participants are advised to only travel within the same vehicle with others from the same household. Participants should consider using their own vehicle and not public transport where possible.
Other users:	Walkers may use the main track although the wood has limited public access. Please be considerate to other users.
Terrain/Hazards:	Mixed woodland with recent felling and thinning; take care when crossing areas with stumps and brashings. Log piles adjacent to tracks must not be climbed on. Drivers arriving at Hens Wood may encounter runners crossing or using the track so please drive carefully. Wildlife particularly deer may be encountered. Ticks and bites may be experienced and competitors should check on finishing and follow NHS advice regarding their treatment.
Maps:	A4 landscape 1:10,000 scale. Contours at 5m intervals.
Times:	Start Times 1100-1200 hrs. Courses close at 1300hrs.
Courses:	 1-hour score event which includes a set of yellow controls. Please note: Controls 151 and 154 etc.are labelled 51 and 54 etc. on the map A section of track and ride either side of assembly is OUT OF BOUNDS
Punching:	EMIT. Card hire fee £1.50 per competitor. Lost card charge £47. Pre-booked EMIT cards will be available at the event assembly area.
Start & Finish:	Start and finish are within 5 minutes of the event assembly area and competitors are requested to stay in the car park area until they need to move to the start.
Entries and Fees:	Strictly Pre-Entry ONLY – no entry on day.
	Entries will be limited to a maximum of 45 individual runners or family groups. Entry will be restricted to NWO members until midnight Wed 7 October and any spaces after this date will be available to members of British Orienteering.

Facilities:	No toilet facilities are provided. First Aid kit available.
