Travel Restrictions: Competitors must abide by any Government restrictions in force at the time of the

event.

Venue / Parking: Cherhill Down is between Calne and Marlborough and will be signposted from the A4

between Beckhampton and Cherhill villages. Grid Ref SU046701, Postcode SN11 8XY. A narrow lane leads from the A4 to the parking area which is on grass adjacent to a fenced enclosure. Traffic on the A4 can be fast, take care leaving or joining the main

road. Please park sensibly and do not obstruct the track.

Other users: The area is well used by the public so please be considerate to other users.

Terrain/Hazards: Open downland with some copses and scattered trees, hillfort and prominent

monument. Fences must only be crossed at marked points.

Maps: A4 landscape 1:10,000 scale. Contours at 5m intervals.

Times: Start Times 1100-1200 hrs. Courses close at 1400hrs.

Courses (TBC): LENGTH ASCENT TECHNICAL DIFFICULTY

Yellow 2.1km 50m Quite easy – suitable for beginners

Orange 2.6km 70m Moderate
Green 3.9km 130m Difficult
Blue 6.6km 290m Difficult

Punching: EMIT. Card hire fee £1.50 per competitor. Lost card charge £50. Pre-booked EMIT

cards will be available at the event assembly area.

Start & Finish: There will be an approximately 700m uphill walk to the start and downhill from the

finish to download and car parking area.

November. Late entries may be available while map stocks last up to 2359 on

Thursday 18th November No entry on the day.

Facilities: No toilet facilities are provided. First Aid kit available.

Dogs: Dogs are permitted on leads.

Safety: All competitors must download, even if they do not complete the course.
