Venue / Parking: Coate Water is a country park on the edge of Swindon near M4 J15. Use

the main car park entrance. Nearest Post code: SN3 6AA See map

Parking will be on the main hardstanding car parks or in an overflow car

park. There is a parking charge (£2.00 for over 2 hours)

Assembly Area: Leave the main car park and pass the toilets on your left and follow the

track round until you see the NWO banner at the Assembly area to the west

of the small lake



Terrain:

Open grassland with some wooded areas and lakes. A full golf course, pitch and putt and crazy golf courses are within the area of the map but all are Out of Bounds for the event. A mandatory crossing point also applies to some of the courses to avoid the main entrance road and car parking area. Buildings include a refreshments kiosk, miniature railway and toilets

Park Users: The park is used by many other people including small children on bikes

etc. so please be mindful and considerate of them while competing.

Map: A4 landscape1:7,500 scale, produced by Mapworks and updated by NWO in 2022

Relay Rules: Each team must run each course twice in six consecutive sessions. No individual to run the same course twice. **EMIT** punching will be used and NWO will provide 2 EMIT cards/team at no additional fee.

When handing over to the team member running the same course handover the map as well. Otherwise, if running the course first, collect the map from the appropriate box at the start.

The details of the order each team runs each course along with handicapped start time will be displayed at the registration tent.

Relay Teams: If there are team changes, if possible, please inform the organiser in advance or as soon as you arrive so any adjustments in handicaps can be taken into account.

<u>Team Captains</u> on arrival, please provide the fee for your team (The fee for the team will be the total of the individual fees for the team members) and collect the EMIT cards.

Relay Courses: 3 courses of about 2km.

Other Courses: For those not taking part in the relay Easy course (for beginners) (2km) and Short Green course (3.4km) for other orienteers

Times: Assembly/Registration 10:15 – 10:55 Relay Briefing 11:05

Handicap Start for Relay with Base Time 12:00 noon.

Starts for other courses from 11:20

Fees: Relay: Adults £8 Juniors £3

Short Green: Adults £8 Juniors £3

Beginners' Course: Adults or Family groups £4, Juniors £3

Fees Include EMIT card hire but £47 charge for lost EMIT card

Individual Course Entry: Those who have already contacted the organiser are guaranteed a map. We will have printed some additional maps for these courses and entries will be available while map stocks last.

Entry Payment will be taken on the day

Covid 19: Do not come to the event if you or anyone you are living with have symptoms of Covid-19 or if you have been advised to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace

NWO Relays Handicap Times

Each team member obtains an age-class related handicap time (minutes) as follows:

M Class	Handicap time	W Class	Handicap time
M14	-6	W14	-7
M16	-4	W16	-6
M18	-2	W18	-5
M20	-1	W20	-4
M21	0	W21	-3
M35	-1	W35	-4
M40	-2	W40	-5
M45	-3	W45	-6
M50	-4	W50	-7
M55	-5	W55	-8
M60	-6	W60	-9
M65	-7	W65	-10
M70	-9	W70	-12
M75	-11	W75	-14

Starts will be at 12:00 noon for non-handicapped runners (i.e. 3 M21 runners) and all others run at 12:00 minus their combined handicaps. For teams of 2 runners the combined handicap will be increased by 50%

Example

A team of 3 consisting of M21, M40 and W50 would have a handicap of -9 minutes and therefore start at 11:51.

Each team should inform registration of their lead runner start time.
