Your Safety

You take part entirely at your own risk. Please note:

- Take care at all road crossings and be aware of and considerate to all road and pavement users.
- Use bridges and underpasses where possible – they are marked on the map.
- Do not cross roads shaded as out-of-bounds, you must only use bridges or underpasses for these.
- Children must be accompanied at all times by a responsible adult.

Description

You will be looking for checkpoints (controls) such as fire-hydrants, lamp posts, post boxes, telegraph poles and signs. When you find them you write down a simple **number clue**. You will be given a map with numbered circles and each control is located at the centre of the circle. The start is the triangle symbol and the finish is the double circle

You will need a pen or pencil

<p align="center">Fire Hydrant</p> <p>A letter H on a yellow background either close to the ground or on a post. There are usually two numbers. In these cases: 75/1 and 75/21</p>	<p align="center">Lamp Post</p> <p>Usually from 1 to 6 digits long eg. 117010</p>	<p align="center">Post PO Box</p> <p>The postbox number is at the bottom eg. SN3 27</p>	<p align="center">Dog bin</p> <p>The number is on the side. Take care. eg. 093694 or CS53</p>	

<p align="center">Telegraph Pole</p> <p>Circular letters and numbers eg. DP589</p>
