## **Conditions of Use for Course Maps and Materials**

Course maps and materials are supplied only on the following conditions

- 1. The copyright for all supplied maps and materials remains with North Wiltshire Orienteers (NWO).
- 2. The map and materials are for the use of the person to whom they are supplied and the group he/she represents. They must not be passed to other persons or groups who have not agreed to these conditions.
- 3. The maps and materials must not be used for organised events attracting an entry fee without the express written permission of both North Wiltshire Orienteers and Swindon Borough Council for each such event.
- 4. Groups of more than 20 who intend to use the Coate Water permanent orienteering course must contact the Coate Water Rangers in advance. (tel 01793 490150).
